

LAPORTE AVE.

FISHBACK TO SUNSET

Project Overview

The City is seeking to improve roadway safety along Laporte Ave. from Fishback Ave. to Sunset St. by addressing deficient sidewalks, adding raised separated bike lanes, upgrading the roadway with curb and gutter, and other traffic improvements.

In 2023 the City replaced two bridges along the corridor that were past their design lifespan. They were widened to accommodate additional modes of travel. In 2024 the City will complete the sidewalks and raised separated bike lanes on the rest of Laporte Ave. from Fishback Ave. to Sunset St.



WOOD TO FISHBACK

Project Overview

The City is seeking to improve roadway safety by restriping Laporte Ave. from Wood St. to Fishback Ave. with buffered bike lanes in summer 2024. On-street parking will have to be removed on both sides of this section of Laporte Ave. to provide enough space for buffered bike lanes.

In 2024, the City will also complete construction of raised separated bike lanes on Laporte Ave. from Fishback Ave. to Sunset St. (see back for more info). Filling the final gap in bicycle facilities on Laporte Ave. from Wood St. to Fishback Ave. is a high priority project in the City's Active Modes Plan.
